The Kenai Peninsula Borough hereby invites qualified firms to submit a firm price for acceptance by the Borough for Road Capital Improvement Projects; consisting of the following:

Furnishing all labor, materials, and equipment for subgrade modification, roadbed widening, embankment reconditioning, and paving of approximately 4,320 linear feet of road. Work includes approximately 1,350 Tons Type II, Class B asphalt, 1,550 Tons D-1 Base Course, 2,500 CY Subbase Grading B, 660 CY excavation.

A pre-bid conference will be held at the Kenai Peninsula Borough Road Service Area office, 47140 East Poppy Lane, Soldotna, Alaska 99669 on March 2, 2017 at 10:00 AM. Attendance at the pre-bid is not mandatory but is strongly recommended.

This contract is subject to the provision of State of Alaska, Title 36, Minimum Wage Rates. The subsequent contract will require certificates of insurance and may require performance and payment bonds.
